Iowa Department for the Blind is working on increasing their transition programs during the school year. They will be partnering with IVRS to provide these services in the summer as well as the LEAP program in Des Moines will be offered again.

IDB is looking at starting their own 4+ program in Des Moines for individuals who need additional independent living skills outside of their IEP. This is in the very beginning stage, but funding has been requested and approved by the state. For adult clients, a new one-week training in Des Moines called SELF is available to help with blindness training.
